Lahar Drill Friday May 3

On Friday, May 3rd we will practice a Lahar Drill. During the Drill students exit the schoolhouse just like during a Fire Drill. Once lined up, Mrs. Day will confirm that all the students have been accounted for, then the she will line the students up in the following order: 8th grade intermingled with the Pre K students, 7th grade/Kindergarten, 6th grade/1st grade, 5th grade/2nd grade, 3rd grade, 4th grade, followed by the Administrative Assistant. The Principal will proceed East on the playground, with students and faculty following between the Parish Center and Parish Hall, around the parish parking lot and then return back to the playground parking lot.

In a real Lahar Emergency, the need to get the students, faculty and staff up off of the valley floor in a quick and orderly fashion is imperative. In an actual evacuation instead of returning to the playground parking lot the Principal will lead the students across the Parish Parking lot, turn left onto 17th street heading east, 17th street Y's into Auburn Way South (route 164), head up the hill to the Muckleshoot Bingo Parking lot on the south side of the road. This is exactly 1 mile from the Parish Parking lot to the parking lot of the Muckleshoot Bingo parking lot. Parents would then pick up their student(s) in the Muckleshoot Parking Lot after they have been signed out by a Faculty or staff member.
