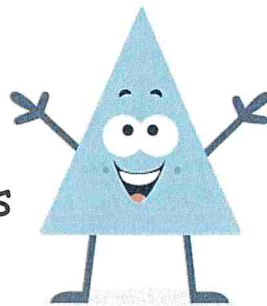
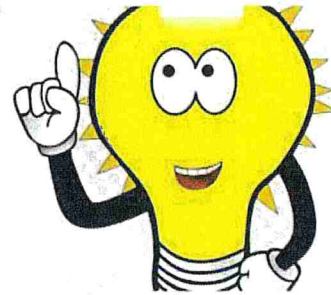


SCRIP NEWS

YES, BUT...



Think about this

and do the math...

CREDIT CARD

SCRIP PROGRAM

Gives back 3%-5% for dining out & groceries	Has several grocery stores and dining options that rebate 5% or HIGHER = MORE \$\$ FOR YOU
Gives back 1%-5% for other purchases	Has many opportunities to earn over 5% rebates = MORE \$\$ FOR YOU
