LEGENDS: Players in 7th to 9th grades celebrate the love of the game in this youth basketball league. Legends focus on learning plays, practicing teamwork and building fundamental skills. Teams participate at a higher level of competition that helps prepare them for playing in school leagues and throughout their entire life.

This is the last reminder before Auction items are due on Nov. 28...just 12 days away!

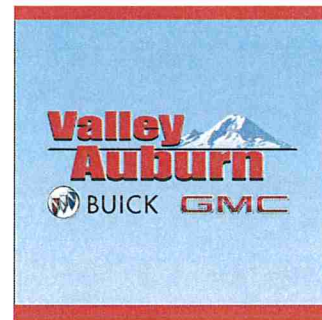

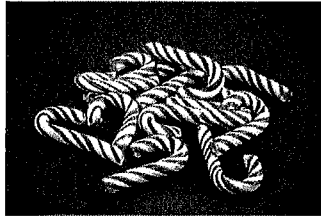
