We are thrilled to present to you our 2023 Spring Tea Musical at Holy Family School, on Friday, March 24th, at 1 PM, in the Parish Hall. The students are continuing to make impressive growth in their musical journey. We would like to inform you of our upcoming band concert in March. **All students are expected to attend this concert.**

This band concert will take place on **THURSDAY, MARCH 16TH, @ 6:30 PM**, in the **Parish Hall** at Holy Family School. Like the last concert, this will feature our 5th Grade Beginning Band, 6th Grade Intermediate Band, and 7th/8th Grade Advanced Concert/Jazz Band.

This will be an opportunity for all the band students at HFS to showcase & perform all the music selections they have been working on in the last few months. All bands will be playing a number of fun, exciting pieces of music, and you will also have the chance to hear a few students who have opted to play a solo or small group selection for the audience.

HFS BUNCO LADIES NIGHT

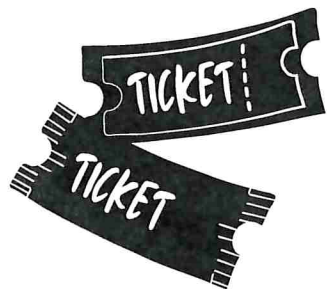
We are hosting another round of the dice game BUNCO for the Holy Family ladies (& non-HFS girlfriends you'd like to invite), you won't want to miss it!

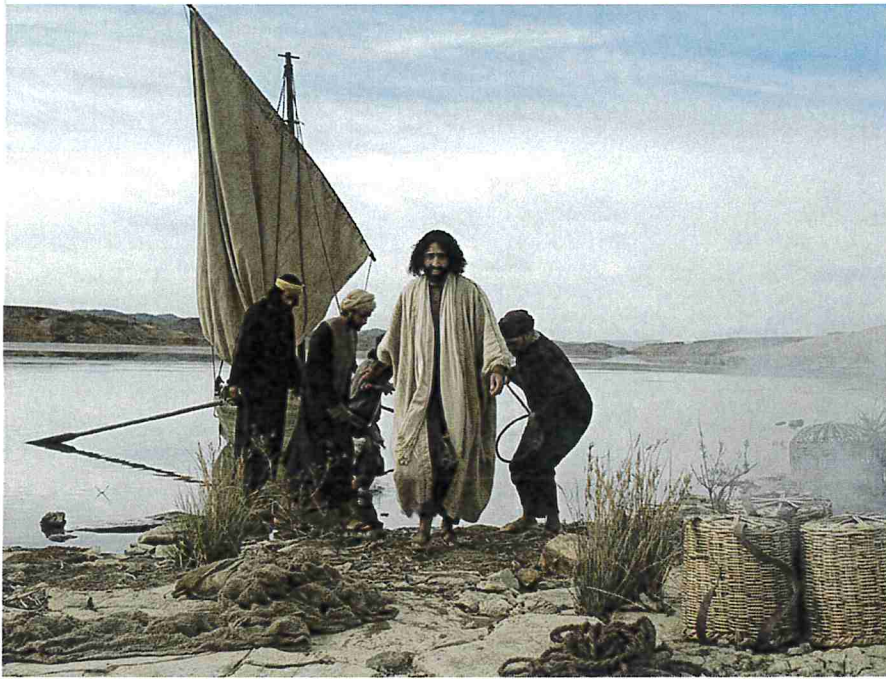
