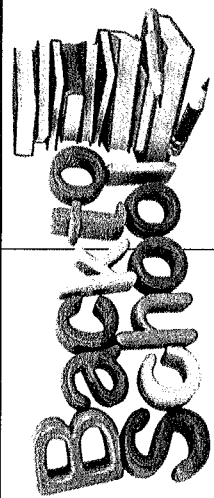

PROFIT DOLLARS

Each family is responsible for earning profit dollars. The fundraising commitment is met when a family:

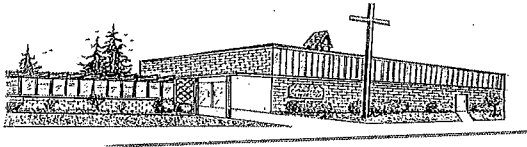
- ❖ Procures items worth a minimum of \$250.00 for the Auction. In lieu of an item you may make a cash donation in the amount is \$250.00.
- ❖ \$275 profit dollars need to be earned through the purchase of SCRIP.
- ❖ \$375 profit dollars need to be earned through the sale of Raffle Tickets.
- ❖ Each family must make a donation to the Annual Campaign.

Profit dollars are funds actually received by the Holy Family School Parent Club. Funds raised for individual classroom projects do not count towards profit dollars.

COMMITMENT HOURS

A minimum of 20 commitment hours are required per family.

- ❖ A minimum of five (5) hours must be worked on the auction and/or as chairperson of another Parent Club Leadership approved fundraising event.

The Archdiocese of Seattle uses **VIRTUS** for its training as well as for tracking Safe Environment compliance. VIRTUS offers a comprehensive program including Safe Environment training for adults as well as children and youth. VIRTUS also provides a more convenient way for participants to register, read and sign Safe Environment policies online, fill out information for criminal background check and register for a Safe Environment class.

Current volunteers who have already completed the foundation class, *Protecting God's Children* or *Called to Protect for Ministries*, **MUST log into Virtus (www.virtusonline.org)** and review all contact information and complete any requirements that are due.

If you do not remember your VIRTUS log-on information please email cbanning@holyfamilyauburn.org to have it reset.

New volunteers will log-on to www.virtusonline.org, click on "First-Time Registrant" to set up their account and follow the steps to becoming compliant with all Safe Environment requirements. (*Run a Background Check, Read Required Documents, Sign up for a Class*) **We will be holding a foundation class at Holy Family of *Protecting God's Children* on Thursday, September 14th at 9 am in the Smith Room.** (You may attend any class that is listed on Virtus if it is more convenient) **You must register for this on the VIRTUS web page.** Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions or concerns. 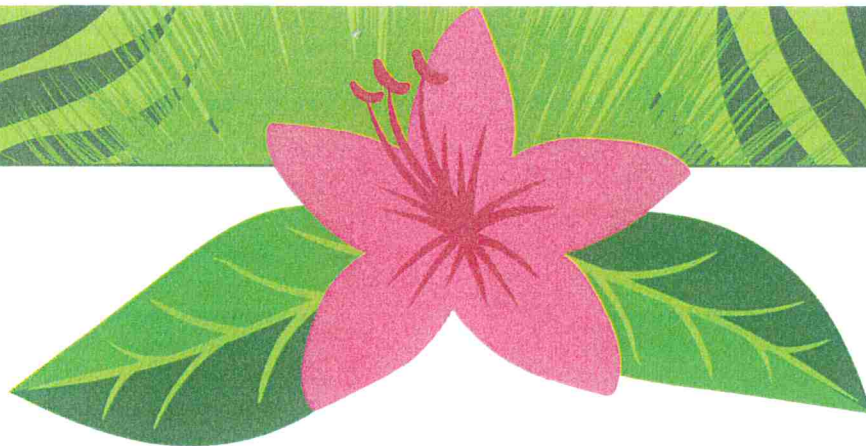
