HIGH HOPES FUND-A-NEED



Each year during the Auction we have a special request for funding. The funding is typically requested for something that is not included in our regular annual operating budget. As in years past 75% of the funds raised go towards the special funding request and 25% of funds raised go to the HFS Endowment Fund.

We are here tonight because we love Holy Family School. We want the best resources and opportunities for our students, academically, spiritually, and physically. Every couple of years we evaluate one area of curricular resources to ensure we have the right tools for providing a rigorous program of study. For a year now we have done our reflection and research on our ELA program (reading and writing) and have found we are in need of new resources.

Tonight, we are seeking your support in funding the purchase of a comprehensive K-8 reading and writing program. We have chosen a program called *Wit and Wisdom*, published by Great Minds.

"Wit & Wisdom® was crafted by teachers, for teachers. With every lesson founded on exceptional texts, all learners are empowered to tackle the rigor of grade-level content with confidence and joy. Core texts are wide-ranging, varied, and provide a careful balance of literary, informational, and fine arts texts."

This program has a foundation of building knowledge while learning the skills of reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Through the use of information-rich anchor texts, our students will dig deep into topics based on what they've read that will build knowledge across lessons. Our primary grades will also use the companion phonics program *Geodes* to create the foundation of skills all readers need to succeed.

The adoption of a new curricular resource is a major investment in our teachers and students. Our purchase this summer will give our teachers all the tools they will need to implement the new program in the fall. Instructional and assessment materials, student texts and workbooks, online resources, and professional development. Our teachers and students are worth the investment!

SOURDOUGH BREAD BAKING CLASS WITH MR. PAIVA

On Friday, May 10 join Mr. Paiva for a two-hour class on sourdough artisan bread baking. Participants will receive sourdough starter, a banneton in which to shape the loaf, directions, and one loaf of bread that they will take home.

Class will cover the basics of maintaining a sourdough starter, how to work the dough, time frames for the whole process, baking tips, and suggested sources for quality ingredients.

Mr. Paiva has been baking artisan bread for over 15 years and recently attended a class taught by the famed owners of Sea Wolf Bakery in Seattle. Class is restricted to no more than 8 participants and will only be offered if there are 6 or more participants. Cost is \$50 per person. Class will be offered in the evening from 6-8:00 at Mr. Paiva's home. Bring a bowl, a wooden spoon & an apron, and prepare to get your hands messy!

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS: The Bid-O-Gram is a separate silent bid auction, running simultaneously during the live auction. It is designed to make bidding easy and convenient for you. You will be able to bid & keep watch on who is the current leading bidder right from your seat.

WHAT ARE THE ITEMS UP FOR BID? The detailed description of each item up for bid can be found in your auction catalog beginning on page 37, in the Auburn Valley Chevron Bid-O-Gram Event section.

HOW DO I BID? Any time you wish to make a bid, just fill out one of the bid sheets on your table and hold it up in the air. A runner will come to collect it. Think of it as Kenostyle bidding! In the event of tying bids, the first bid arriving at the Bid-O-Gram table will be recorded.

CAN I BID ON MULTIPLE ITEMS? CAN I BID MORE THAN ONCE? Absolutely! There is no limit on how many times you can bid. As competing bids are received, the current highest bid name, bid number and amount will be shown on the screen. If your bid number is not shown, that means it's time to fill out another bid sheet and make another bid for any dollar amount. There are no guaranteed bids in this section, thus bids can go as high as you desire.
