Course Description

Social Studies: Your student will be using *TCI's History Alive! The Ancient World*. This curriculum provides a physical textbook and an electronic interactive notebook. Your student will learn about early humankind and the development of human societies. The course will begin the rise of Sumerian city-states and conclude with the fall of the Roman Republic. They will learn about the contributions of ancient China, Africa, and Meso-America. In the spring, your student will complete a Country Report. Detailed information regarding the project expectations and timeline will be provided to both parents and students at a later date.

Science: Your student will be using *Houghton Mifflin Harcourt Science Dimensions* for their Science curriculum. The curriculum is divided into three sections and your student will focus on one section each trimester. The sequence is as follows: Cells and Heredity, Ecology and Environment, and Diversity of Living Things.

- 5 or more days late - no credit

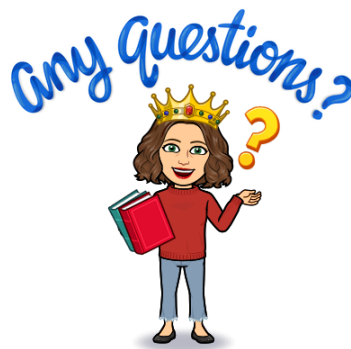
Parents will be notified of late assignments.
