Course Description

For the first and second trimester, your student will be using *TCI's History Alive! The Medieval World and Beyond*. This curriculum provides a physical textbook and an electronic interactive notebook. Your student will learn about the fall of the Roman Empire, the influence of the Catholic Church, and Feudalism in Medieval Europe. Your student will also learn about the Muslim empires and the Crusades. We will spend time learning about cultural and political developments in Imperial China, Feudal Japan, West Africa and Meso-America. We will conclude with the Renaissance and the Reformation in Europe. Washington State history will be covered during the third trimester. This course will focus on the history of Washington State in its regional and national context. The curriculum will examine the role of Native Americans and immigrants as well as how our state's geography and geology continue to shape the way we live. This course will cover your student's High School Washington State History requirement.
