Course Description

Social Studies: Your student will be using *TCI's History Alive! The United States through Industrialism*. This curriculum provides a physical textbook and an electronic interactive notebook. 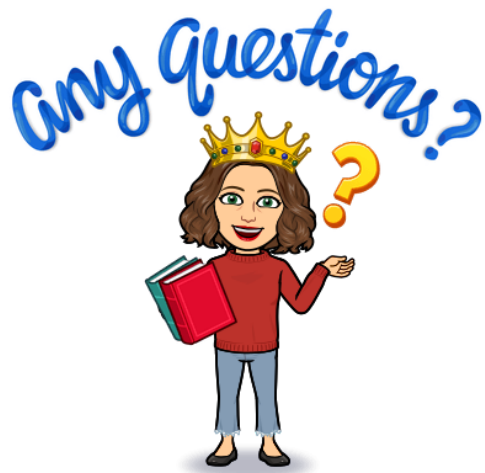
