In Archbishop Etienne article in this month's Northwest Catholic he reminds us that, "Lent calls us to our senses to humbly acknowledge where we have lost our way, and thus our need to be reconciled to God." This morning Fr. Roy spoke to this when he called us all to conversion. The ashes marked on our foreheads are a sign of our salvation, that we were brought forth from dust, and in dying we will return to dust but be born to eternal life.
