All k-8 classrooms have completed their MAP Growth: Reading assessment. Over 30% of our students made double digit growth on this assessment since last fall. We also have a strong 70% of students meeting or exceeding national normed benchmarks.

We are wrapping up math in all grades this week, and our grades 4-8 are showing strong with another 70% meeting or exceeding national normed benchmarks.

Our students have worked tremendously hard this year, and their teachers have journeyed with them every step of the way.
