MAP Testing

Three times a year our students will participate in the Measures of Academic Progress testing. These adaptive tests track student academic growth over time. The testing window for the fall runs from September 11th through October 6th. Our students complete the bulk of their tests during the first two weeks of the testing window (see schedule below). Fall testing is for students in grades 1-8. Our first graders will engage with the math and reading assessments while our students in grades 2-8 will engage in the math, reading, and language assessments. Student reports will be shared in late October after the window is closed.

Holy Family School has done well on these assessments in the past, and I believe we will have a good showing this fall. That begins with all of you! Here's some ways you can help set your child up for success during our testing window:

- 1. Help them achieve a good night's rest the day prior (that would be tonight!)
- 2. Start their day with a hearty breakfast
- 3. Do what you can to help mitigate their anxiety
- 4. Provide good "fuel" food for snack and lunch time their brains before and after testing will be hungry!
- 5. Make sure your child has their water bottle
- 6. Encourage your child to do their best, take their time, and to not worry!
- 7. When the day is done, congratulate your child for accomplishing great things =)

Adult Volunteer Information

If you think you may volunteer for field trips or in the classroom during the school year, Safe Environment requirements must be up to date.

Safe Environment Training is mandated by the Archdiocese of Seattle. Any adult volunteering on campus or in the classroom, driving on a field trip, assisting at lunch, during recess or at Extended Care, running a club or teaching an after school class, is required to be up to date with Safe Environment training and have a current background check.

Returning parents are reminded to check their Virtus account. The background check is valid for three years. When it is time to renew your background check, you will be required to take an online refresher Safe Environment class.

New volunteers must take the initial Safe Environment Class Protecting God's Children. Held at different parishes throughout the Archdiocese, you may sign up for the in-person class at any local parish or school. To

pre-register for the three hour foundation class and initiate a background check, you must create a profile and electronically sign policies through the Virtus database. https://www.virtusonline.org/virtus/index.cfm

Holy Family Parish will be offering the foundation class on **Thursday**, **September 14th at 9:00am in the Smith Room**.

Please note: if your background check or training is not current, you will not be able to volunteer at Holy Family School.
