School Announcements:

MAP Testing

Three times a year our students will participate in the Measures of Academic Progress testing. These adaptive tests track student academic growth over time. The testing window for the fall runs from September 11th

through October 6th. Our students complete the bulk of their tests during the first two weeks of the testing window (see schedule below). Fall testing is for students in grades 1-8. Our first graders will engage with the math and reading assessments while our students in grades 2-8 will engage in the math, reading, and language assessments. Student reports will be shared in late October after the window is closed.

Holy Family School has done well on these assessments in the past, and I believe we will have a good showing this fall. That begins with all of you! Here's some ways you can help set your child up for success during our testing window:

- 1. Help them achieve a good night's rest the day prior (that would be tonight!)
- 2. Start their day with a hearty breakfast
- 3. Do what you can to help mitigate their anxiety
- 4. Provide good "fuel" food for snack and lunch time their brains before and after testing will be hungry!
- 5. Make sure your child has their water bottle
- 6. Encourage your child to do their best, take their time, and to not worry!
- 7. When the day is done, congratulate your child for accomplishing great things =)

Accreditation Parent Survey

As part of our self-study process this year we will be gathering information from all parents, students, and staff. This is done first through surveys and then through specific task groups. Our accrediting body, WCEA, has created the different surveys based on the National Standards and Benchmarks for Effective Catholic Schools (NSBECS). Visit this site for a review of the <u>NSBECS</u>.

This survey is designed to help our school shine a light on all that we are doing well and bring to the surface the areas where we can grow. There are five sections to the parent survey, one section to tell us who you are, and then four asking 42 specific questions in reference to the standards. The final question allows for a free response.

Completing the survey in one sitting is ideal, so before you take the survey I request that you create a space and time for yourself to really pray and discern your responses considering all that you have experienced with and know of our school.
