### **Back-to-School Night**

#### **MAP Testing**

Each fall, winter, and spring the Archdiocese gathers academic data from students within our schools using the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments. Our students in grades 1st-8th will participate in the fall session this year. Students will be assessed in the areas of math, reading, and language. Please be on the lookout for more information from your homeroom teacher about specific testing days and ways you can

help prepare your child at home. These assessments are meant to track progress over time, and I trust that each student will do their best in each situation. The window for MAP testing runs from September 12th - October 7th.
