HFS Fabulous Fifties Auction Newsletter

Thank you to all that have already turned in your procurement items. For those that have not, here are some procurement TIPS to help you meet the upcoming Nov 28th procurement deadline:

Tip #1: Carry copies of the Procurement letter and form with you. These are available on the auction page on the HFS Auburn website. Let's make sure everyone in the Auburn community and surrounding areas is aware of the HFS Auction and has an opportunity to donate!

Tip #2: Approach businesses where you **already spend money**. When you are out eating, shopping, at classes & events with your kids, at your haircut, massage, spa appointment, etc., ask to talk to the manager or owner, and let them know how much you've enjoyed your experience. Then, give them a procurement form, tell them about HFS, and ask them if they would consider donating the same service or item. If they recognize you as a customer, the owner is more likely to donate!

Tip #3: Remember to **emphasize the purpose of the auction.** Prospective donors like to know where their donation is going and that it will have an impact. If you can speak candidly with a potential donor about HFS, you will get their attention. Perhaps you have a personal story on how HFS has significantly impacted your child and your family's life.

Tip #4: Make it easy: be specific! If you ask them for a *specific item or service*, it is often easier for them to say "yes", than "no". "Can you donate that Kindle?" "Our guests love to bid on wine – can you donate a bottle?" "How about a \$100 gift certificate?" "Will you consider donating five hours of your professional expertise (architect, electrician, auto mechanic)?" "Would you consider donating your tickets to a Seahawks game during the season?"

Tip #5: **Follow up personally**! If you leave a procurement form with a potential donor but haven't heard back, stop by the store, or give them a quick call to see if they have any questions about the procurement form. We lead busy lives, and a little "prompt" may return the donation to the top of their to-do list!

Tip #6: Meet the deadlines! For an item to be included in the catalog, the procurement form needs to be turned in at the very latest by **November 28th**. The item itself can be delivered at a later date.

Tip #7: Think creatively and have fun! Many businesses have budgets set aside for donations, as well as a special interest in helping the local community. Most people are more than happy to make a donation.

This is a great opportunity to educate people in our community about the wonderful things that happen at HFS. Be proud of asking people to join with us to support such a worthy cause. Every donated item makes a difference!




