

During this week of showing appreciation, I want to say a big thank you to everyone who supports our Scrip Program. Thank You!!

- In the past 20 days, together, you all have earned \$1515 in profit dollars!
- Total profits to date are about \$15,600
- 11 families have earned more than \$275
- 6 families are within \$20 of meeting their goal
- 31 families are over half way to making their profit dollar commitment
- 30 families purchase mostly eGift Cards except for local vendors
- 7 families purchase ONLY eGift Cards
 - o 6 of those families have exceeded their commitment

Principal update:

SCRIP

14,207 total collections thus far

2022 - 2023 FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENTS

Each family is responsible for raising money to meet the HFS Parent Club commitment of \$115,000 to the school's budget.

PROFIT DOLLARS

Each family is responsible for earning profit dollars. The fundraising commitment is met when a family:

- ❖ Procures items worth a minimum of \$250.00 for the Auction. In lieu of an item you may make a cash donation in the amount is \$250.00.
- ❖ \$275 profit dollars need to be earned through the purchase of SCRIP.
- ❖ \$275 profit dollars need to be earned through Parent Club fundraisers.
- ❖ Each family must make a donation to the Annual Campaign.

Profit dollars are funds actually received by the Holy Family School Parent Club. Funds raised for individual classroom projects do not count towards profit dollars.

COMMITMENT HOURS

A minimum of 20 commitment hours are required per family.

❖ A minimum of five (5) hours must be worked on the auction and/or as chairperson of another Parent Club Leadership approved fundraising event.
