Last Call for Auction Volunteers. Still could use spotters, a recorder and raffle ticket sellers. Contact Gretchen.

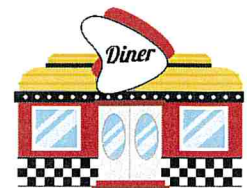

We are thrilled to present to you our 2023 Spring Tea Musical at Holy Family School, on Friday, March 24th, at 1 PM, in the Parish Hall. You will have the pleasure of watching our Pre-K through 4th grade students present 3 fantastic musical programs with lots of singing, acting, dancing, and high energy, along with some beautiful scenery & artwork. We will also be serving refreshments such as tea & treats to enjoy during the performance.

-  Our Pre-K, Kindergarten, and 1st graders will be performing "Barnyard Moosical", an imaginative mini-musical about a unique & talented group of animals living at this unusual farm.
-  Our 2nd & 3rd graders will be performing "Bugz", a fun-filled musical about a picnic where every bug gets to pitch in, such as Ladybugs, Fireflies, Army Ants, Bumblebees, and then, uh oh.... a Stinkbug wants to come over as well??!!
-  Our 4th graders will be performing "The Adventures of Lewis & Clark", which tells the story of Captain Meriwether Lewis & Captain William Clark who travel, explore, & chart the new territories of the Louisiana Purchase, under the leadership of President Thomas Jefferson. These three men set out on the expedition with their companions, York, Charbonneau, Sacajawea, and their trusty dog, Scannon. This remarkable story comes to life with 8 entertaining songs, and a very entertaining script.

Our kids have been working hard on learning the songs, their lines, and telling these stories to you through their music.

The show will begin at 1 PM in the Parish Hall; **doors will be open at 12:45 PM for families to arrive and take their seats. Students should bring their costumes to school that day and be ready to wear their attire for the performance.**

I hope this email finds you well as we're now in the 2nd half of the school year!

The students are continuing to make impressive growth in their musical journey. We would like to inform you of our upcoming band concert in March. **All students are expected to attend this concert.**

This band concert will take place on **THURSDAY, MARCH 16TH, @ 6:30 PM**, in the **Parish Hall** at Holy Family School. Like the last concert, this will feature our 5th Grade Beginning Band, 6th Grade Intermediate Band, and 7th/8th Grade Advanced Concert/Jazz Band.

This will be an opportunity for all the band students at HFS to showcase & perform all the music selections they have been working on in the last few months. All bands will be playing a number of fun, exciting pieces of music, and you will also have the chance to hear a few students who have opted to play a solo or small group selection for the audience.

The call-time for this concert: We will have an **arrival window of 5:30-5:45 PM** for all students/families to arrive. We will meet in the school library first, where students can assemble their instruments before heading to the parish hall. Cases and personal items will be stored off-stage in the hall during the concert. If this changes, we will let you know ASAP. The back parking lot will be open for parking and students will access the school through the main doors in the breezeway.

Concert attire: Students may come dressed in uniform if they wish, however, we'd like to note that formal attire, such as white tops, black slacks, concert dress, etc, is also encouraged for this performance.

Parent Help: Once again, we are looking for parent support to set up and clean up the hall for the event. See the grade level assignments below to know when and how to help for this first concert. I will provide a layout for chair arrangements and Mrs. Day will be there to guide as needed. The jobs have rotated for this concert (if you have kids in multiple grades, you can choose one of the tasks below). Thank you in advance for your support in this way:

7th/8th Grade Parents: Providing refreshments for after the performance! (cookies, juice, etc)

6th Grade Parents: Setting up chairs for the audience.

5th Grade Parents: Putting chairs (and other stuff) away, sweeping the floor, etc.

The students continue to grow in leaps and bounds, bring great enthusiasm and take a good deal of ownership & pride in their musical pursuits. 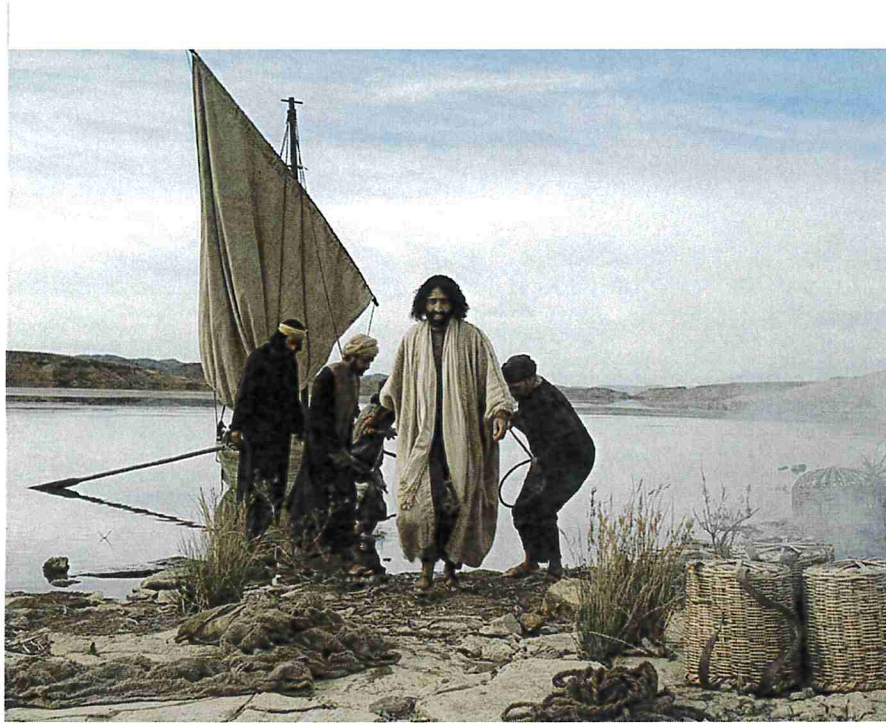
