# **Principal Message**

Greetings Holy Family,

Happy Easter! Our students and staff have returned to school this week ready to learn and be together. It is a joy to see each of them after the vacation.

For the last year the Archdiocese of Seattle has been engaged in Partners in the Gospel, a reorganization of parishes into parish families. This past weekend the announcement was made on the new pastors for parish families. Priests all across the Archdiocese are moving to new parishes, the largest priest shuffle ever attempted for us. The new priest assignments will take effect on July 1st. Fr. Roy, who has been our pastor for six years, is moving up to the Snohomish area to serve as parochial vicar for a new parish family. Serving our parish family of Holy Family and St. Andrew will be Fr. Jerry Burns as pastor and Fr. Thomas Tran as parochial vicar. The first year with the new parish family and canonical leadership will be a time of transition as we work on the plan for how we will unify as one parish family. We can expect many things to stay the same, with some changes sprinkled in. All this to say, we have a few months left with our beloved pastor, Fr. Roy. He is committed to our parish and school and will continue to lead us as we prepare to say goodbye to him and hello to our new leadership.

About a month ago I shared updates on staffing for the upcoming 2024-25 school year. There is more to share.

- Mrs. Marcoe (Eaton) she has requested to change roles in the building instead of returning to her position as kindergarten teacher
- Mrs. Cordero our current kindergarten teacher has decided to take a position at another school for the new year. She has been a blessing to us the second half of this year and will be missed

When this news was shared with the staff, two current teachers expressed their interest in changing grade levels.

- Ms. Boespflug current 2nd teacher interested in moving to kindergarten
- Mrs. Hammond current 5th teacher interested in moving to 2nd

Official assignments will be finalized next month when I offer teaching covenants to our teachers. This change of grade levels now leaves an opening for a new 5th grade teacher. I will be posting this position to our hiring portal by the end of the week.
